What is laido?

laidō is a <u>Japanese martial art</u> that emphasizes being aware and capable of quickly drawing <u>the sword</u> and responding to sudden attacks.

laido consists of four main components, as practiced in the Kata (Solo Forms): the smooth, controlled movements of drawing the <u>sword</u>, striking or cutting an opponent, cleaning the blade, and resheathing the sword in the scabbard.

In laido, the emphasis is on precise, controlled, fluid motions. This art is sometimes referred to as "moving Zen (meditation).

New students begin their practice of laido with a wooden sword (<u>bokken</u>). With time, these students will begin to practice using a blunt-edged sword called an <u>iaitō</u>. Only at the top levels of experience will iaido practitioners use a sharp-edged sword (<u>shinken</u>).
